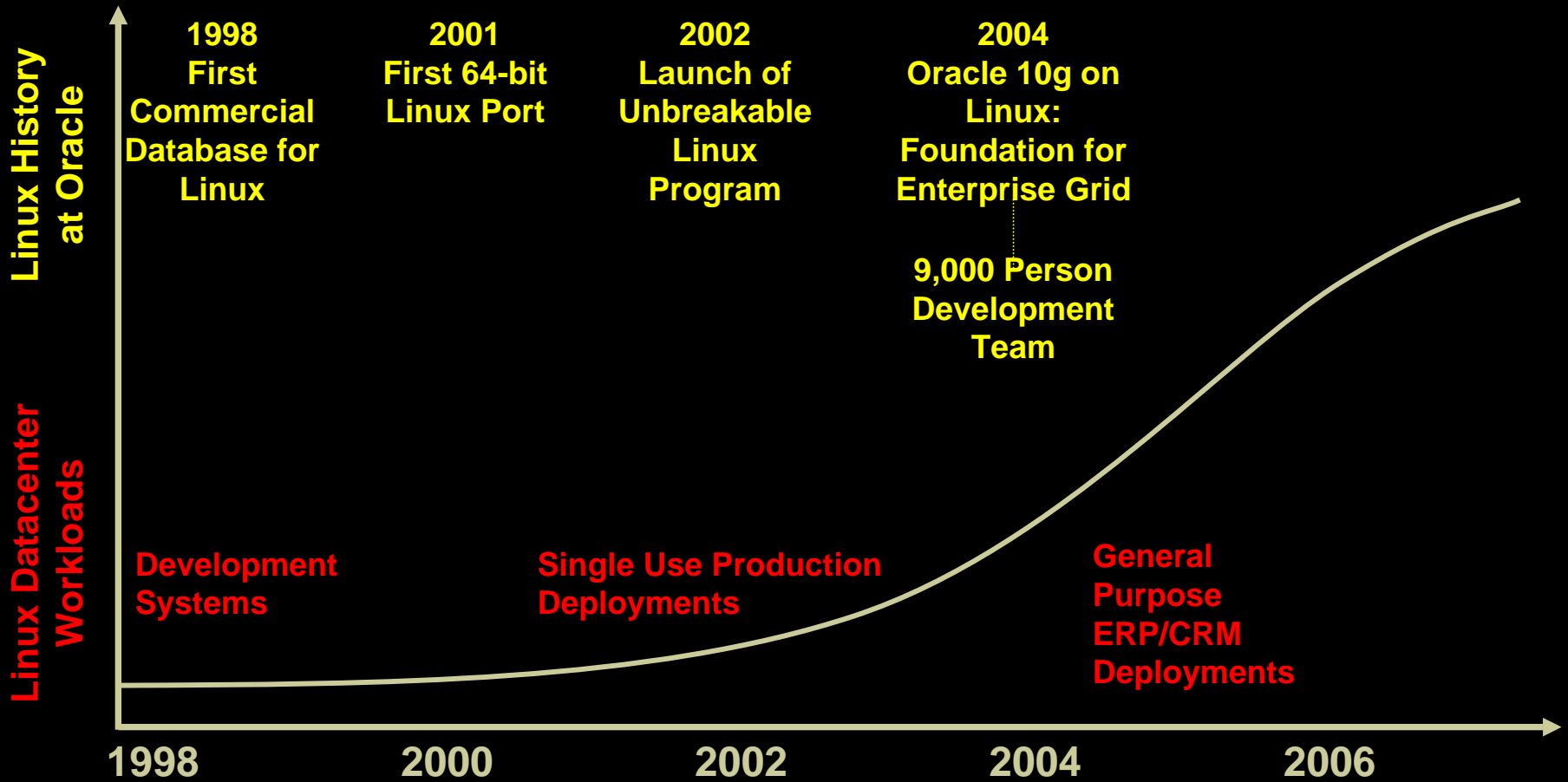

Oracle's Linux Strategy – Unbreakable Linux

Technology Leadership

- **Product Availability:** All Oracle products available on Linux
- **Security:** Oracle Database on Linux meets EAL4
- **Performance:** Industry leading benchmarks for Oracle products on Linux
- **Kernel Enhancements:** performance, reliability and manageability enhancements to Linux
- **Open Source Contributions:** E.g., Oracle Cluster File System

Support Leadership

- Only vendor to provide support for the entire software stack, including Linux

Market Leadership

- Leads RDBMS on Linux market with 69% market share (source: Gartner Group)
- Key partnerships with Linux OS vendors and OEMs

Technology Leadership

- Contributes to open-source under GPL
 - e.g. Oracle Cluster File System
- Works with Novell, Red Hat and the open source community to drive features into Linux
